- The owner of Temple Bruer, David Bruer, is Australia's foremost organic viticulturist and nurseryman.
- They measure how much CO2 is produced from all the processes, even including the product's purchase as well as those performed by the team up until the wine is sold. Self-audited and then verified by Canopy, an Australia initiative helping companies develop carbon offset programs.
- Thanks to bottling technologies the winery is able to replace sulfur dioxide with attention to detail.
 Minimal oxygen interacts with the wine and create a product that is as fresh as possible without unwelcome preservatives.
- All the wines meet the European Union standards for creating wine w/out the need for chemical preservatives.

"Vins Doux Naturels"

- Vin doux means sweet wines made by using the "mutage" method.
- Mutage is when the yeast action is halted before any fermentation begins & is halted by the addition of alchohol.
- The result is really a blend of wine, unfermented grape juice & added grape spirit.
- The sweetness comes from the unfermented sugar not grape dehydration like dessert wines.
- After the wine is produced wine is placed in open barrels to oxidise, called "contrived oxidation"
- Then transferred into oak casks to age for another 5 years. Depending on the winemaker, the wine is placed into barrels, demi barrels and Foudre
- In the 5 year, means the youngest lot is 5 years.

- Quinta de Romeira has been around since 1703
- 130 ha, 75 of which are vineyards, mainly of the Arinto grape variety.
- winemaker wanted to make this an easy going white and is why it has 6 g/L of residual sugar.
- Amongst Douro, Lisbon is the biggest wine producing region in Portugal.



- ROTHENBERG soil type: red slate; Racy Rieslings with pleasing mineral note
- KÖNIGSSCHILD soil type: shell stone; limestone smooth Rieslings with distinctive aroma with amazing acid notes.
- LÖHRER BERG soil type: coarse gravel; that produces delicate fruity wines often with citrus notes

- In early 1800's, Domingo Eyzaguirre II, planted some of the first vines from French rootstock and founded Vino de Eyzaguirre winery in what later became San Francisco de Mostazal, a village built by monks from a nearby Franciscan monastery.
- The Franciscan monks discovered that burlap sacks protected precious bottles from breakage during their bumpy trip by horse-drawn cart.
- The idea caught on with the winery & became a tradition that has endured to this day.
- Each bottle is wrapped by hand, as well as the application of the labels.




The Journey to Sustainability

Sustainable practices are those that meet the needs of the present generation without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs.

It is being a steward of both natural and human resources.

Sustainability is not just "environmental sustainability."



How can wines be made without SO2?

- Temple Bruer has used internal trials to select certain yeast strains which when temperaturecontrolled during fermentation produce very little or no sulphur dioxide.
- Post fermentation the wines need to be temperature controlled, below 10 degrees is ideal and oxygen exclusion through a reticulated carbon dioxide system is used daily in the tanks.
- The final stage in preservative free winemaking and bottling needs to be done with great care and consideration to exclude oxygen and ensure good bottle filtration. Bottling under screwcaps also helps to reduce the ingress of oxygen to the wines and maintains their freshness for longer.

What is ISO 14000?

ISO 14000 is a globally recognized Quality Environmental Management Program that focuses on a winery's environmental footprint, and helps the winery to continually reduce its environmental impact. It is a rigorous affiliation that requires three years to complete, and then is constantly monitored thereafter.

- Organic standards for the vineyard (no fertilizers or pesticides)
- Soil erosion controls, Air quality controls
- · Composting of all organic waste
- Natural cooling in the winery and in the offices
- Wastewater recycling, Water saving irrigation practices
- Cleaning tanks and other vineyard equipment without chemicals
- Plant/animal diversity around the vineyard
- Enhancing natural ecosystems
- Recycling within offices
- Working to lower the carbon footprint of the winery as a whole



What is Carbon Neutral mean with Temple Bruer?

- We were the first in Australia to plant Arundo donax to harvest CO₂ — this special weed captures more CO₂ than any other plant
- We use a pyrolysis kiln which turns green waste into biochar
- Biochar is charcoal made from plant matter. It is a soil amendment (maintains nutrients & water in the soil) as well as capturing CO2
- In its biochar form, (Char + Manure) 1 tonne = 3.7 tonnes captured CO2
